Also sire of Champion Hurdle hero **SUBLIMITY** and useful hurdlers **BLYTHE KNIGHT**, **PASCO** and **SCORNE**D.

Gr.1 winners on the flat include **THISTLE BIRD**, **ANNOUNCE**, **KASTORIA** (Irish St. Leger), **SULK**, **RED BLOOM**, **WINCE** (1000 Guineas), etc.

DAM

Aiken is out of the Group 1 placed Sadler's Wells mare Las Flores, making him a brother to Group 3 winner **FELICITY** and a half-brother to successful sire **SLEEPING INDIAN** (sire of the winners of over 300 races, 12 black type performers including four black type winners) and Stakes performers **JALISCO** and **NATIONALISM**.

Las Flores is from the family of **TOP VILLE**, sire of **BENEFICIAL**, **UN DESPERADO**, **NORWICH** and **TOULON**.

All offspring sold to date have made an average price of over 5 times his covering fee.
